SUBJECT: Certificate of Networthiness for PureEdge Internet Commerce System (ICS)  
Viewer and Designer, Phase 1 Deployment

1. The PureEdge ICS Phase I is hereby granted a certificate of networthiness CON-02-0071. PureEdge ICS consists of two COTS desktop products to replace FormFlow. This networthiness certification is for this version only. The PM must notify HQ AFCA/WFSL of any subsequent releases or changes to the system's security, interoperability or sustainability to determine if a new networthiness assessment is required.
2. HQ AFCA review of system documentation has determined that PureEdge ICS Phase I does not require any unique network connectivity to operate and is ready for Air Force-wide implementation based on the following factors:
  - a. PureEdge has no network capabilities of its own
  - b. PureEdge utilizes existing web browser and email
  - c. Bandwidth is expected to be the same or less than existing FormFlow
  - d. Documentation reviewed: 1) Command, Control, Communications, Computers, and Intelligence Support Plan (C4ISP); 2) System Security Authorization Agreement (SSAA); 3) Port and Protocol Matrix; 4) Network Risk Assessment (NetRA) Checklist; and 5) Security Policy Compliance Assessment (SPCA) Checklist
