### **SUMMARY OF REVISIONS**

**This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.**

**PACAFI 23-204, 14 August 2000, is supplemented as follows:**

10. "A", "A-1", "B", "B-1", "C", "C-1", bags will be centrally stored in base supply's MoBag Section in built up or Tariff sized configuration with the exception of 15 SFS and 25 ASOS squadrons who will store their "A" and "A1" bags, 15 SFS stores "B" bags. For real world deployments, the Army will issue 25 ASOS "C" bags.

10.1. 15th Logistics Readiness Division will store "C and C-1" bags in built-up configuration in sufficient quantities to meet OPLAN taskings.

12.2. The MoBag Section hand receipt will be both preprinted and handscribed.

15.2. Canisters will be stored in the "C and C-1" bags.

15.3.3. The MoBag Section is responsible for accountability of the MCU 2A/P mask and will maintain/issue the mask. Hand receipts will be used to issue masks to responsible individuals.

15.4. Units will purchase and maintain their own CWDE training equipment.

15.5. Special sized clothing must be purchased from General Services Administration (GSA).

21.2. CWDE inspections will be documented on DD Form 1574, Serviceable Tag Materiel.

24. Canisters will be stored in the "C and C-1" bags.

28.4. Funded CWDE prioritized list of base level requirements should be validated annually.
