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SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

Implements PACAFI 36-2201, *Simulator Training Management*, 23 September 1994. This supplement completely revises the previous edition. This supplement applies to Kadena Air Base, it's attached and detached units.

PACAFI 36-2201, 23 September 1994 is supplemented as follows:

- 2.1.2. 18 OG/OGV will appoint F-15 and KC-135 Wing Simulator Training Officers (WSTOs).
- 3.1.2. F-15 Mission Qualification and Continuation training will be in accordance with MCI 11-F-15, Vol 1, 18 WG Sup 1.
- 3.1.3. F-15 Simulator Instructor training will be in accordance with MCI 11-F-15, Vol 1, 18 WG Sup 1, Attachment 8.
- 3.1.4. Simulator Certifications (SIMCERTs) are accomplished annually by the 18 WG and periodically by outside agencies (in the case of a major simulator modification, for example). A copy of the annual 18 WG SIMCERT report will be forwarded by the WSTO to the 18th Operations Group Commander within 5 duty days. For SIMCERTs accomplished by other agencies, the WSTO will forward a copy of the report within 5 duty days of receipt
- 3.1.10. (Added) Ensure that a copy of the most recent Standardization and Evaluation Review Board minutes is maintained at the simulator.
- 4.1.14. (Added) Provide records of deviations and scheduling changes monthly to the 18 OSS/CC.
- 5.1.1. (Added) Squadron training officers will work with the WSTO to implement the wing simulator program.

5.1.2. (Added) Squadrons will provide Entry and Authorization lists to the PO/QAR quarterly, as a minimum.

8.1.4. (Added) Whenever any item of equipment is inoperative that will affect scheduled missions, the PO/QAR will notify 18th Operational Support Squadron Scheduling (18 OSS/OSOSF), who, in turn, will notify the affected flying units. The simulator may be used to accomplish missions not dependent on the inoperative systems.

10.2. (Added) Squadrons will provide 18 OSS/OSOSF with weekly simulator requirements for inclusion in the wing weekly schedule.

10.3. (Added) Annual SIMCERT missions will be annotated on the weekly schedule.

11.1. The flight simulator manager will coordinate with 18 OSS/OSOF before submitting the monthly AFLC 1351 report. All deviations to the published schedule that require added, deleted, or late sorties will be coordinated through 18 OSS/OSOSF. The 18 OSS/OSOSF will, in turn, notify the flight simulator manager.

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
