

MAIL THREAT CHECKLIST

HOW TO IDENTIFY SUSPICIOUS PACKAGES AND LETTERS

THE WEARING OF PROTECTIVE GLOVES IS MANDATORY FOR POSTAL CENTER MAIL HANDLERS

NOTE:

Screening for EXPLOSIVE, RADIOLOGICAL, CHEMICAL, and BIOLOGICAL hazards includes checking every piece of mail for the following characteristics:

1. PRIORITY ONE
 - a. Fails Ion or X-Ray screening, if available.
 - b. Oily stains, discolorations, crystallization on wrapper or leaking powder or fluids, strange odor.
 - c. Excessive weight, oddly shaped, has soft spots
 - d. Protruding wires or aluminum foil
 - e. Ticking sound
 - f. Suspicious/Threatening messages written on exterior
2. PRIORITY TWO
 - a. Excessive postage or no postage
 - b. Possibly mailed from a foreign country
 - c. No return address or fictitious address
 - d. Poorly written or typed addresses, cut/paste lettering
 - e. Incorrect/inaccurate titles
 - f. Title, but no name
 - g. Misspellings of common words
 - h. Lopsided, unusually rigid or uneven envelope
 - i. Excessive wrapping material such as masking tape, string, etc.
 - j. Visual distractions
 - k. Marked with restrictive endorsements, such as "PERSONAL"/"RUSH"/"CONFIDENTIAL"/"FRAGILE"/"DO NOT DELAY"/"HANDLE WITH CARE"
 - l. Shows a city or state in the postmark that does not match the return address

SUSPICIOUS UNOPENED LETTER OR PACKAGE

1. PRIORITY ONE

DO NOT shake or open the LETTER or PACKAGE
TURN OFF all wireless communication devices (e.g. Cell phones, pagers)

- a. ISOLATE/SEGREGATE the LETTER or PACKAGE in a safe place.
- b. LEAVE the LETTER or PACKAGE in the open
 1. PLACE "suspicious package" tag near it, with the arrow pointing toward it

- d. REPORT (include WHO, WHAT, WHERE) the incident to:
 1. SECURITY FORCES _____
 2. BUILDING MANAGER _____
 3. SUPERVISOR _____

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- e. WASH your hands with soap and water to prevent spreading any potentially dangerous substances to your face
- f. LIST all people who were in the room or area when the LETTER or PACKAGE was determined to be suspicious

NOTE:

Give this checklist to the PUBLIC HEALTH and LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS for follow-up investigations, advice, medical follow-up, etc.

- g. DELAY DELIVERY of all mail in the bag/batch, until the suspicious LETTER or PACKAGE is checked and cleared by authorized personnel

SUSPICIOUS OPENED/LEAKING LETTER OR PACKAGE

DO NOT shake or empty contents of the LETTER or PACKAGE. DO NOT try to BRUSH OFF or CLEAN UP anything that has spilled on your clothes or in the immediate area

1. CONTAIN any further leakage of potentially dangerous substances.
 - a. If possible, PLACE the LETTER or PACKAGE in a PLASTIC BAG or some other type of container to prevent leakage of contents
 - b. If no container is available, then COVER/DRAPE the LETTER or PACKAGE with anything (e.g. Clothing, paper, trash can) and do not remove the cover
 - c. PLACE "suspicious package" tag near the LETTER or PACKAGE, with the arrow pointing toward it

4. Wash your hands with soap and water to prevent spreading any potentially dangerous substances to your face
5. If clothing is contaminated, DO NOT attempt to brush off. Remove and place in plastic bag(s) or remain still and await direction from first responding public health or law enforcement.
6. LIST all people who were in the room or area when the LETTER or PACKAGE was determined to be suspicious, especially those who had actual contact with the potentially dangerous substance

DO NOT use BLEACH or other DISINFECTANT on your skin.

7. When practical, SHOWER with soap and water.
