The OPR for this supplement is 30 LRS/LGRDMP. AFMAN23-110, Volume 6, Chapter 4 and AFSPCSUP1 are supplemented as follows: The purpose of this supplement is to provide guidance for processing turn-ins of precious metals, identify the organization and shop code to be used and assign an Issue Exception Code (IEX).

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

Deletes references to 30 SUPF. Specifies the required semi-annual reports will be sent to the accountable officer. Changes the supply organization and shop code used for turn-in of precious metal-bearing materials from 407 PR to 120 PR. A bar (|) indicates a revision from the previous edition. This publication has been substantially revised and must be reviewed in its entirety.

4.2.2.3.1. The 30th Medical Group Precious Metals Recovery Program (PMRP) monitor will process all turn-ins of precious metals generated by the medical facility.

4.2.14. Semi-annual (January & July) summary of transactions will be forwarded to the accountable officer for use in any directed audits.

4.6.4. Issue Exception Code (IEX) "P" will be assigned to item records which have a Precious Metals Indicator Code (PMIC) assigned, or that contain a recoverable amount of any precious metals.

4.9.1. Organization and shop code 120 PR will be used for turn-in of precious metal-bearing materials.

4.9.7.1.1.2. Organization and shop code 120 PR will be used.
