SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

1.1.2.1. All Squadron First Sergeants will be considered Key and Essential, however, they will not receive priority housing. Waivers for First Sergeants to willingly remain off base must be submitted to the 319 CES/CEH to be reviewed by the 319 SPTG/CC.

1.1.3. All Key and Essential personnel should inform the Housing Management Office of any changes in their status, such as PCA or PCS to ensure a smoother transition for Key and Essential inbound member.

1.2. All personnel, except for designated personnel and approved hardships, may indicate a preference for the type of quarters listed. Personnel who express no preference will be offered any quarters that become available consistent with their grade and family size. When an excess of vacant adequate housing is readily available, personal preference will not be authorized. Types of housing are:

MCP. Three and four bedroom single level and two story duplex.

Capehart. Two, three and four bedroom two-story and single level.

Relocatable. Two and three bedroom single level duplexes.

Townhouse. Four bedroom, two story.
