AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 19, 1 October 2002 is supplemented as follows:

This publication implements AFPD 23-1, *Requirements and Stockage of Material*. This supplement does not apply to Air National Guard or Air Force Reserve units and members.

NOTE: Due to regionalization, PACAF Regional Supply Squadron or the Base Customer Service Center can perform tasks in AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 19. Refer to PACAF Supplement 1 to AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 19 and PACAFI 23-206 for further breakdown of responsibilities.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.

19.1.2.1. (Added) Stock levels for local purchase (Routing Identifier = Jxx) items will not be established.

19.8.1. Vehicle tires will be procured using the Government Purchase Card (GPC). Supply Points will not be maintained. Semiannual review of vehicle tires is not required.

19.8.4.3. Vehicle Maintenance does not use Contractor Operated Parts Store (COPARS) procedures. Tires are either procured through the Standard Base Supply System or using the GPC.

19.21.1.1. (Added) Base Customer Service Center (BCSC) monitors exception codes for local purchase items (Routing Identifier = Jxx).

19.21.2.2.1. (Added) Exception Control Record (ECC) instructions for local purchase assets (Routing Identifier = Jxx) will be loaded to the item record nomenclature using a File Maintenance Miscellaneous Data Change (FNL) input. External records are not required when using this method.

19.22.2.4.4. (Added) Stockage Priority Code (SPC) E will be loaded to all local purchase (Routing Identifier = Jxx) items to prevent automatic stock replenishment and be reviewed quarterly using an Automated Stock Number User Directory (ASNUD) script report. The listing will be kept on file until the next quarterly review.

19.31.1.1. (Added) BCSC will route adjusted stock level requests (AF Form 1996) for potentially hazardous items through the Hazardous Material Pharmacy (HAZMART) prior to forwarding to PACAF RSS/LGSMS to ensure the requester is authorized. HAZMART NCOIC recommendations will be annotated in the justification block of the AF Form 1996.

19.76.5.4. Refer to AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 19, PACAF Supplement 1, Paragraph 19.76.5.4. and 19.76.5.4.1. through 19.76.5.4.3. for guidance on reduced price sales.

19.76.6.1. NOTE: BCSC will conduct a semiannual (Jan/Jul) validation of excess exception codes loaded to local purchase (Routing Identifier = Jxx) items using an ASNUD script report. NCOIC of BCSC will maintain the signed validation for 6 months or until next review is complete.

19A10.4.1. (Added) HAZMART will manage the assignment and deletion of the health hazard flag and issue exception codes 8, 9, and M.

Table 19F3.1. The following local excess exception code is assigned with monitor responsibilities as indicated:

B	Radioactive Control	R	N	LGSCI

Table 19F3.1. Note 5. (Added). Excess Exception Code B is assigned IAW AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 14, Paragraph 14.41.3.3. All Type Cargo Code A or 4 stock numbers will have this excess code assigned to further identify radioactive material.
