AFMAN 23-110, Vol. 2, Part 2, Chapter 23, 1 April 2003 is supplemented as follows:

This supplement implements AFD 23-1, *Requirements and Stockage of Material*. This supplement does not apply to Air National Guard or US Air Force Reserve units and members.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.

23.8. (23.8. in PACAF SUP) LRS Commander waives requirement to establish a Base Service Store due to support of a contracted Base Service Store (BSS) and Individual Equipment Element (IEE).

23.23. IEE operations are contracted out.

23.23.1.2. LRS Commander has elected to exclude Chemical Warfare Defense Equipment included Table of Allowance Source 016, part C.

23.23.2. LRS Commander has elected not to assign Issues Exception code “E” to one-time requirements.

23.31.3.4.1. LRS Commander has elected to create one-stop out-processing. Personnel out-processing will stop at the Mobility Element and Base Customer Service Center to perform all actions required to obtain an LRS Commander’s clearance letter. This must be accomplished prior to member’s final out-processing appointment with 354 MSS.

23.37.9.1. Grade insignias are procured using the Government Purchase Card (GPC).

23.38.2.1. Government cleaning facility is available locally to facilitate retention item cleaning. (Also applies to 23.71.2.1.)

23.41.6. (23.41.6. in PACAF SUP) LRS Commander declines the option to issue unserviceable, non-Equipment Authorized In use Detail returnable clothing, which is otherwise transferred to the Defense Reutilization Marketing Service. (Also applies to 23.42.6. and PACAF SUP 23.42.6.)

23.44.1.1. (23.44.1.1. in PACAF SUP) LRS Commander declines the option to establish a BSS due to support of a contracted BSS/IEE.

23.54. (23.54. in PACAF SUP) LRS Commander declines the option to establish a BSS due to support of a contracted BSS/IEE. (Also applies to 23.55. and PACAF SUP 35.55.)

23.58. (23.58. in PACAF SUP) MAJCOM has authorized LRS Commander to contract out IEE operations.

23.61.8.1. (23.61.8.1. in PACAF SUP) LRS Commander declines the option to maintain a central file of AF Form 2005 and due-out management notices. This process is no longer under control of Supply due to BSS/IEE being contracted out.

23.106.1. (23.106.1. in PACAF SUP) LRS Commander declines the option to set the frequency of reports due to IEE operations being contracted out.

23.109.2. (23.109.2. in PACAF SUP) LRS Commander declines the option to determine where the floppy diskette will be maintained. LRS Commander relieved of this requirement due to BSS being contracted out.

23.114.2. (23.114.2. in PACAF SUP) LRS Commander declines the option to determine how the Base Automated Service Store system transactions are processed. LRS Commander relieved of this requirement due to BSS being contracted out.

Attachment 23C-2. Note 1 (Attachment 23C-2 in PACAF SUP) AF Form 1297 may be used for non-EAID organizational, mobility and WRM items as long as the type category is entered in the national stock number and article block.

Attachment 23C-2. Note 2 (Attachment 23C-2 in PACAF SUP) NF1 accountability for mobility bag items is waived. Items are accounted for in the Mobility Inventory Control and Accountability System (MICAS).
