**AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 17, is supplemented as follows:**

17.11.1. Refer to PACAFI 23-203, *Combat Oriented Supply Organization (COSO) Procedures*, Chapters 2 and 7.

17.11.5. A local cannibalization log will be used to document reportable cannibalization transactions.

| 17.16.4.1. The 374th Logistics Readiness Squadron Materiel Section Aircraft Parts Store (374 LRS/LGRDMA) upon direction from Pacific Air Forces Regional Supply Squadron (PACAF RSS) will prepare post-post lateral support shipping documents.

17.19.1. Refer to 374 AWI 23-201, *Local Manufacture Procedures*.

17.24.3. The awaiting parts (AWP) monitor will accomplish these duties.

| 17.25.1. The AWP monitor is assigned to PACAF RSS in accordance with PACAFI 23-206, *PACAF Regional Supply Procedures*, paragraph 9.1.9.
