SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This supplement renumbers and updates all paragraphs to correspond to the basic manual. A bar (|) indicates revision from the previous edition.

AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 24, is supplemented as follows:

| 24.11.1. The 374th Logistics Readiness Squadron Distribution Flight Chief (374 LRS/LGRD) will appoint turn-around (TRN) managers.

24.13. The 374 LRS Distribution Flight Materiel Section Flight Service Center (FSC) (374 LRS/LGRDMF) will be the central location for processing due-in from maintenance (DIFM) turn-ins.

24.18.1. The 374 LRS/LGRDMF Superintendent will monitor part two of the D20/NGV821, Base Supply Surveillance Report, and file issue requests with the report.

24.18.1.1. The 374 LRS/LGRD will approve or disapprove initial issue requests.

24.31.1. One semi-annual supply point reconciliation will correspond with the annual supply point inventory in March.

24.32. The 374 LRS Management and Systems Flight Accountability Section (374 LRS/LGRSP) will conduct supply point inventories.

24.38.1. 374th Maintenance Squadron (374 MXS) is responsible for the operation of buildup supply points.

24.46.1.1. (Added) Maintenance Facility, Plans and Scheduling (MF PS) will forward monthly, a copy of the time change forecast listing to FSC. FSC will ensure national stock numbers (NSN) are loaded and, if necessary, requisitioned with good status. Listings will be maintained until no longer needed.

24.55.3. The Time Compliance Technical Order (TCTO) Manager, 374 LRS Distribution Flight Materiel Section Aircraft Parts Store (APS) (374 LRS/LGRDMA) will process TCTO kits issued.

24.55.7. NOTE: The TCTO Manager will process issue requests.

24.56.1. The 374 LRS Distribution Flight Cargo Movement Inbound Element (374 LRS/LGRDCI) will process all TCTO receipts and FSC will process all turn-ins and maintain all TCTO items. FSC may have a bulk storage area within the main warehouse if needed.

24.60.4. Refer to PACAFI 23-203, *Combat Oriented Supply Organization (COSO) Procedures*, Chapter 6, for detailed instructions on the TCTO reconciliation process.
