**AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 26, is supplemented as follows:**

| 26.8.2. The 374th Logistics Readiness Squadron War Readiness Section (374 LRS/LGRRW) will review dated items.

| 26.9.1. The 374 LRS Materiel Section Aircraft Parts Store (APS) (374 LRS/LGRDMA) will act as the functional check monitor for war readiness assets.

| 26.9.3. Mobility Readiness Spares Package (MRSP) assets will be held in a functional check holding area.

| 26.13. The 374 LRS Procedures and Accountability Section (374 LRS/LGRSP) will accomplish a complete inventory of all transferred and loaned kits.

| 26.26.2.2. The 374 LRS/LGRDMA personnel will use Automated Stock Number User Directory (ASNUD) script files and logbooks for short-term deployments.

| 26.43.1. The 374 LRS/LGRRW will manage and maintain A, B, and C bags.
