DEPLOYMENT BAG MOVEMENT

COMPLIANCE WITH THIS PUBLICATION IS MANDATORY

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This supplement applies to all assigned, attached, tenant, and satellite units.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

Updates office symbols. A bar (|) indicates revision from the previous edition.

PACAFI 23-204, 14 August 2000, is supplemented as follows:

7. Shop code 710 MK will be used for A, A-1, and B bags. Shop code 710 CW will be used for C, C-1 bags, and bulk chemical warfare defense equipment (CWDE) assets.
10. 374th Logistics Readiness Squadron War Readiness Element (374 LRS/LGRRW) will store A, B, and C bags. A-1, C-1, mask, and training gear will be issued to individuals and stored by using organizations.
 - 10.1. C bag authorizations for primary deployment positions will be stored in C bag configuration.
 - 12.2. A, B, and C bags for primary deployment positions will be bulk shipped. A-1, C-1, mask, and training gear will be issued to individuals and stored by using organizations.
 - 12.2.2. 374 LRS/LGRRW will file hand receipts in last name sequence. 374 LRS/LGRRW personnel will attempt to contact the individual 2 weeks after estimated return date. If items have not been returned 30 days after individual's return date, 374 LRS/LGRRW personnel will prepare a letter from the 374 LRS Commander (374 LRS/CC) to the individual's unit commander requesting corrective action.
 - 12.2.5. 374 LRS/LGRRW will inform the appropriate resource advisor via e-mail, letter, or telephone of the amount and person prior to processing expense transactions.
 - 15.1. 374 LRS is not required to size personnel and will not record size on the back of the individual's shot record.
 - 15.2. C2/CSA1 canisters will be stored in prebuilt C-1 bags. C2/C2A1 canisters will be stored in bulk for C bags.

15.3.2. The MCU-2A/P protective mask tariff for Yokota is 16% short, 60% medium and 24% long.

15.3.3. 374th Airlift Wing Commander (374 AW/CC) requires the 374 LRS/LGRRW to maintain and issue MCU-2A/P mask.

15.3.3.6. Procedures to charge organizations for replacement parts are located in PACAFI 23-204, *Deployment Bag Movement*, paragraph 12.2.5.

15.4. Training gear will be issued by the 374 LRS/LGRRW to units that have a requirement.

15.5. 374 LRS/LGRRW will issue and order special sized clothing items to the individuals. Mobility inventory control and accountability system (MICAS) receipts will only reflect items issued from the 374 LRS/LGRRW. Special sized items will be stored with individual's bag located in the using organization. Special sized items will be deployed with assigned bag by using organization. Special sized items will be input into MICAS as belonging to using organization and will be assigned a location.

16. Two complete CWDE ensembles will be issued to individuals. These ensembles will be stored and maintained by gaining individual.

16.2. All military and civilians personnel designated as emergency essential will be issued complete basis of issue (BOI) of CWDE within 10 days of arrival in threat area.

16.2.1. (Added)) Ten days prior to departure, military and civilian personnel will turn in all CWDE items to the 374 LRS/LGRRW.

16.3. The 374 LRS/LGRRW will disseminate routine shelf-life information and disposal instructions through unit disaster preparedness representatives and unit deployment managers (UDM). Time-critical information will be passed on through command channels, e-mails, battlegrams, or other appropriate means.

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
