This supplement applies to the Headquarters (HQ) 374th Airlift Wing (374 AW) and its subordinate, attached and tenant units, to include HQ Fifth Air Force (5 AF) and HQ United States Forces, Japan (USFJ). This supplement describes the Project Ride Along Program.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.

| AFI 31-201, 4 December 2001, is supplemented as follows:

12.5.7. (Added) Project Ride Along allows personnel on Yokota Air Base (AB) to ride with the 374th Security Forces Squadron (374 SFS) patrols as an observer and become familiar with 374 SFS duties. Personnel may volunteer to participate in this program, or unit commanders and first sergeants may refer members of their unit to participate in this program as a method of gaining a better understanding of 374 SFS duties.

12.5.7.1. (Added) Personnel participating in Project Ride Along must sign a 374 AW Form 6, **Project Ride Along Application**, prior to riding. If the person is a minor, the sponsor must sign the form. The form will be returned to the participant immediately after termination of the ride.

12.5.7.2. (Added) The ride may be terminated in the event the patrol person is dispatched to an incident that may endanger the rider.
