AFI 11-215, 6 May 1994, is supplemented as follows:

5.6.1.1.1. (AMC1). An AMC Form 446, Flight Crew Information File, will be issued by the Standardization Evaluation Division, 375 OG/OGV, to ensure all aircrew members are aware of changes to manuals, directives, and forms.

5.6.1.1.2. (AMC1). During nonduty hours, interim supplements affecting 375 AW aircraft are received in the Scott Command Post (SCP) by message. Upon receipt of an urgent interim supplement message, the SCP duty officer or controller will notify the 375 OG/OGV on-call point of contact, who will determine if the supplement applies. If the supplement applies to any 375 AW aircraft, the SCP duty officer will determine the units and/or locations of the aircraft affected and retransmit the supplement as follows:

5.6.1.1.2.1. (Added) The C-9A supplements will be transmitted to the next base of intended landing with instructions to pass to the crews or will be transmitted to 375 AW aeromedical evacuation units for relay to crews.

5.6.1.1.2.2. (Added) The C-21A supplements will be transmitted to the next base of intended landing with instructions to pass to the crews or will be transmitted to 457 AS/DOV and 458 AS/DOV for relay to crews.
