**SUMMARY OF REVISIONS**

This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.

**AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 13, Chapter 3, is supplemented as follows:**

**3.7.1. NOTE.** The unit bench stock monitor will input routine replenishment requests over a remote terminal when bins reach a 50 percent level or below. Emergency requests, at one bin per transaction, will be input as needed to fulfill mission requirements.

**3.7.2.** The requesting organization assumes Bench Stock responsibilities. This includes a weekly walk-through of each bin location, checking flagged items, replenishing out of stock items, conducting monthly inventories, and binning property.

**3.8.1. (Added) (3WG).** At the option of the Chief of Supply and the supported organization commander bench stock reviews will be conducted annually in accordance with AFMAN 23-110, Vol 2, Pt 2, Chap 25, *Bench Stock Support*, paragraph 25.23.3.1.
