PACAFI 23-204, 14 August 2000, is supplemented as follows:

10. The 3rd Supply Squadron, Individual Issue Element (IIE) will maintain and centrally store "A," "C," and "C-1" bags in bulk storage facilities. "A-1" bags will be stored at the using organization. "C-1" bags issued to individuals will be maintained and stored by the individual, and turned in to IIE when taken off mobility, permanent change of station, or separation. "B" bag items will be issued to individuals through IIE.

12.2. The 3rd Supply IIE will preprint and store hand-receipt listings in each mobility bag. "C" bags will be bulk shipped when deployed.

15.3.3. The 3rd Supply IIE will account for, maintain, and issue masks to authorized individuals.

15.4. Units will account for, maintain, and issue their own training equipment/gear.

15.5. Individuals will order special sized clothing through the 3rd Supply IIE. The IIE will store and add items to the individuals deployment bag.
