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This instruction implements Air Force Policy Directive (AFPD) 21-1, *Managing Aerospace Equipment Maintenance*. The purpose of this publication is to provide Manual Job Control Numbers during Core Automated Maintenance System (CAMS) downtime in accordance with AFI 21-101, *Maintenance Management of Aircraft*.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

The publication series number has changed from Information Management (37) to Maintenance (21); format has been updated and corrected to include the applicable antecedent policy directive. Changes the notification responsibilities from Data Processing to the Host Database Management and the Base Network Control Center (BNCC) (paragraph 1). Clarifies procedures to follow if the downtime is known (paragraph 1). A (I) indicates revisions from the previous edition.

1. Responsibilities. The 442d Logistics Support Squadron Analysis/Database Management section (LGLOA) will notify Host Database Management and the Base Network Control Center (BNCC) to determine the extent of the problem and estimate the time in which CAMS will be inoperable. If the downtime is known or estimated to last 72 hours or longer, LGLOA will contact HQ AFRC/LGQRI. At any time CAMS is not available or when local management directs manual Job Control Number (JCN) reporting will be implemented.

2. Procedures. All workcenters will maintain copies of frequently used screens and AFTO Form 349, **Maintenance Data Collection Record**. Each form will be dated and numbered and will be maintained until the maintenance data is input into CAMS.

2.1. Plans, Scheduling and Documentation has assigned manual event id's for all workcenter including Inspection Dock.

2.2. At the time the system comes back on-line, each workcenter will input their transactions in a timely manner in chronological order.
