SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This supplement has been revised in order to reflect all the changes from the recent 446th Airlift Wing reorganization. They include changing all reference from 446 LG to now reflect 446 MXG; 446 AGS to now reflect 446 AMXS; 446 SPTG to now reflect 446 MSG; 446 LSS to now reflect 446 MOF; 446 OLBV AFRRCS (RS) to now reflect OLBV 604 RRF; includes 446 AW/SE, 446 LRF and 446 SVF.

A3.2.2. The use of categorical (CAT) address letters for the 446th Airlift Wing (AW) will be as follows:

A3.2.2.1. (Added) **WING/GROUP COMMANDERS**. This group is comprised of the 446 AW/CC, 446 MSG, 446 MXG, and the 446 OG.

A3.2.2.2. (Added) **WING/GROUP/SQUADRON COMMANDERS**. This group is comprised of the WING/GROUP COMMANDERS (listed in para **A3.2.2.1. (Added)**) and the 36 APS, 86 APS, 97 AS, 313 AS, 446 AES, 446 ALCF, 446 AMDS, 446 AMXS, 446 ASTS, 446 CES, 446 LRF, 446 MOF, 446 MSS, 446 MXS, 446 OSF, 446 SFS, 446 SVF, and the 728 AS.

A3.2.2.3. (Added) **WING/GROUP/SQUADRON COMMANDERS & STAFF AGENCIES**. This group is comprised of the WING/GROUP/SQUADRON COMMANDERS (listed in para **A3.2.2.2. (Added)**) and the 446 AW/CCC, 446 AW/CCX, 446 AW/FM, 446 AW/HC, 446 AW/HO, 446 AW/IG, 446 AW/JA, 446 AW/ME, 446 AW/PA, 446 AW/SE, and the OLBV 604 RRF (RS).

A3.2.2.4. (Added) **SQUADRON COMMANDERS & FIRST SERGEANTS**. This group is comprised of 36 APS, 86 APS, 97 AS, 313 AS, 446 AES, 446 AMDS, 446 AMXS, 446 ASTS, 446 CES, 446 LRF, 446 MSS, 446 MXS, 446 SFS, and the 728 AS.

NOTE: All categorically addressed correspondence may be addressed as either WING/GROUP COMMANDERS, WING/GROUP/SQUADRON COMMANDER, WING/GROUP/ SQUADRON COM-

MANDER & STAFF AGENCIES or SQUADRON COMMANDERS & FIRST SERGEANTS. Distribution of CAT letters will be made by the 446th Information Systems Flight (446 MSS/SCB) according to **Attachment 5 (Added)** of this supplement. Each designated CAT addressee will assume responsibility for disseminating information to all sections under their control. A survey on the distribution of CAT letters will be conducted, as needed. Emphasis will be on the minimum number of copies required to accomplish the mission. CAT addresses will not be used for distribution of classified correspondence.
