This pamphlet implements Air Force Policy Directive (AFPD) 36-29, *Military Standards*. It establishes guidelines for recognizing, on an annual basis, an individual who best exemplifies the Air Force core values. It applies to all military individuals assigned to the 446<sup>th</sup> Airlift Wing (446 AW).

**1. Purpose.** Recognize outstanding mission leadership that is all-inclusive and everlasting. The three pillars of integrity first, service before self, and excellence in all we do provide the foundation for mission leadership at every level. This annual award serves to recognize a 446 AW military individual whose professional leadership is a demonstration of the United States Air Force core values.

**2. Prerequisites:**

2.1. Member must present integrity first.

2.1.1. Member must demonstrate courage, honesty, responsibility, accountability, justice, openness, self-respect, and humility.

2.2. Member must present service before self.

2.2.1. Member must demonstrate behaviors of rule following, respect for others, discipline and self-control, and faith in the system.

2.3. Member must present excellence in all we do.

2.3.1. Member must demonstrate product/service excellence, personal excellence, community excellence, resources excellence, and operations excellence.

**3. Nomination Process:**

3.1. All recipients must be nominated by the Command Chief Master Sergeant.

3.2. A letter of selection will be submitted by the Command Chief Master Sergeant to the 446 AW Commander (446 AW/CC) by 1 Feb of each year.

3.3. The Command Chief Master Sergeant Award winner will be recognized and presented their award at the annual 446 AW Awards Presentation.
