This pamphlet implements Air Force Policy Directive (AFPD) 36-29, *Military Standards*. It establishes guidelines for recognizing, on an annual basis, those individuals who demonstrate a superior military bearing worthy of recognition. It applies to all individuals assigned to the 446th Airlift Wing (446 AW).

1. Purpose. Many draw conclusions about people and organizations based upon first impressions. As such, when we wear our uniform, we are giving perceptions about the United States Air Force. This annual award serves to recognize those 446 AW individuals whose appearance in uniform is a manifestation of their high esteem for the Air Force.

2. Prerequisites:

- 2.1. Member must present a neat and clean appearance.
- 2.2. Member must be in compliance with AFI 36-2903, *Dress and Personal Appearance of Air Force Personnel*.
- 2.3. Uniform must be neat, clean, and in good repair.
- 2.4. Boots must be clean, black, and polished.
- 2.5. Member must demonstrate a professional attitude and possess a good working relationship with fellow reservists.
- 2.6. Member must stand out from their peers at the time of the selection.
- 2.7. Member must demonstrate outstanding military bearing.

3. Nomination Process:

- 3.1. All recipients must be nominated by their commander. Commanders may enlist the help of their first sergeants.

- 3.2. A "Look Sharp" letter of selection will be submitted by each squadron commander to the Command Chief Master Sergeant (446 AW/CCC) by 1 Feb of each year.
- 3.3. All "Look Sharp" award winners will be recognized and presented their awards at the annual 446 AW Awards Presentation.
