This supplement implements and extends guidance of Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 23-110V2PT2CH24, *Repair Cycle Support*, and AFMAN 23-110V2PT2_AFSPCSUP 1. This supplement describes 45 SW procedures for use in conjunction with the basic AFMAN and AFSPC Supplement. It applies to all 45 SW activities, tenants and contractors operated or supported by the USAF Standard Base Supply System. This supplement does apply to Air Force Reserve Command and Air National Guard units.

24.3.1. The COSO (Combat Oriented Supply Organization), LOGOPS/LGRSD, is responsible for the operation of Repair Cycle Support.

24.11.1. The TRN Monitor is appointed by the Storage and Issue Supervisor.

24.11.1.5.2. The option to use the Daily Document Register is elected.

24.13. The COSO is the designated location for processing DIFM turn-ins.

24.13.1. (Added) The generating activity is responsible for preparation of the TIN documentation (AF Form 2005 and AFTO Form 350). Three copies of the AF Form 2005 and AFTO Form 350 should accompany the reparable assets. If the assets being processed are under DIFM control, copies 2 and 3 of DD Form 1348-1A, if available, should also accompany the property.

24.18.1.1. The Storage and Issue Supervisor is responsible for approving requests for initial issues/back-orders.

24.18.1.4. The file is maintained in COSO. A single initial issue request is required each year to cover NSN 6660 01 285 1299 Radiosonde sets expended during the year when weather balloons are sent out over the ocean and they cannot be recovered. Each initial issue for a Radiosonde set will reference the letter on file in COSO. The Bill of Materiel (BOM) may be used in lieu of the initial issue letter request by the RTS contractor when it is annotated "INITIAL ISSUE", it contains complete justification, and it has been approved by the Storage and Issue Supervisor.

24.22.1. Supply points may be established by the supply manager in coordination with the applicable maintenance control officers or organizational managers.

24.22.3. **NOTE:** EOQ items must be approved over \$2,500 and approved by the supply manager.

24.25. **NOTE :** When the F025 Management Notice is produced it will be distributed as follows:

24.25.1. (Added) Copy 1 to the Supply Point Monitor.

24.25.2. (Added) Copy 2 to Stock Control.

24.25.3. (Added) Copy 3 to Repair Cycle Support.

24.25.4. (Added) The Repair Cycle Support will suspense the F025 Management Notice to the Supply Point Monitor requesting initiation of AF Form 1996. If a reply/action is not received within thirty (30) days, the supply point detail will be decreased or deleted as appropriate.

24.55.2.3. The SBSS TCTO Kit Monitor will input issue requests to create due-outs and requisitions for each TCTO kit.

24.56.6.3. **NOTE:** TCTO Kit Monitor will process the issue request.

24.61.4. Formal reconciliation meetings are not required and are not held. Informal meetings between the TCTO monitor in COSO and the supported activity (Material Control) are held monthly.

24.61.5. The reconciliation listing will be used in the place of formal minutes and signed IAW 24.60.5, AFMAN 23-110.

Table 24A2.2. (Added) The following DIFM status codes are authorized for ACC units.

Code	Definition	Determined by/Notes
ZCP	Used to identify repair cycle assets in maintenance that are part of the HQ ACC Gold Flag Program. Time spent coded as "ZCP" will be accumulated as delayed maintenance time and not affect the average repair cycle days.	Maintenance
ZRJ	Used to identify items returned to the repair shop for additional action such as, improper container, missing tags, incomplete tags or item, cleaning, missing parts, etc.	Maintenance
ZTO	Used to identify repair cycle assets in maintenance that have been issued to comply with TCTO for which a TCTO kit number has not been assigned.	Maintenance
