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This supplement implements and extends guidance of Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 23-110V2PT2CH25, Research and Records Maintenance, and AFMAN 23-110V2PT2_AFSPCSUP1. This supplement describes 45 SW procedures for use in conjunction with the basic AFMAN and AFSPC Supplement. It applies to all 45 SW activities, tenants and contractors operated or supported by the USAF Standard Base Supply System. This supplement does apply to Air Force Reserve Command and Air National Guard units.

27.17.1.4. Part number detail records will be established for all items to identify specific user/end item application (for example, organization or code, CMAS, T.O. number, etc.).

27.28.2. SPS will be used in lieu of the DD Form 1348-6 file.

27.30.11. (Added) Procured items applicable to AN/FPS-16, AN/MPS-25, AN/TPO-18 or AN/FPS-13 radar sets, which are not assigned valid NSNs and are listed in the Instrumentation Radar Support Program (IRSP) "Balance and Consumption Report," will be loaded as follows:

27.30.11.1. (Added) Routing identifier JBZ will be assigned to all XB3 items. Routing identifier F96 will be assigned to all XD2 items.

27.30.11.2. (Added) REX Code "V" will be assigned to all XB3 items. REX Code "5" will be assigned to all XD2 items.

27.30.11.3. (Added) EEX Code "1" and IEX Code "S" will be assigned to all items.

27.30.11.4. (Added) Budget code will be blank on all JBZ items and O (alpha) on all F96 items.

27.30.11.5. (Added) A BDR (Reparable Item Movement Control Data) with priority designator 06; ship to (DOD Activity Address Code) EZ 1636 will be input for each new item record load (FIL) or item record indicative data change (FIC) processed on items with routing identifier F96.

27.31.1.5. The DD Form 1348-6 will be used.

27.32.2.1.1. The off-line serialized log will reflect the CAGE.

27.32.9.2. The Query Language Processor (QLP) will be utilized to accomplish BVUC 25 interrogations.

27.36.1. The Chief of Supply elects not to perform an annual reconciliation.

27.38.4.2. Computer terminals in Records Maintenance will be utilized for input of internal record updates. Personnel processing new item record loads may use FED LOG printouts as source document in lieu of AF Form 1991, General Purpose Creation.

27.42.3.1.1. The Stock Number Directory may be maintained in electronic file.

27.42.3.1.2.2. The ASNUD will be used in lieu of manually posting the M-14.

27.42.3.2.1. Option 1 applies. File the Document Register (DO4) by date sequence in a separate binder and keep until a new stock number directory is prepared.

27.42.3.4.2. Use the supplementary listing produced by NV404 ISG update. This listing will be retained until receipt of a new Interchangeable and Substitute Group (ISG) Listing (R02). Listing will be located in Records Maintenance.

27.92.3.2.1. (Added) Written requests will be filed in stock number sequence.

27.92.10.1.1. (Added) The correspondence file will be in stock number sequence.

27.118.3. (Added) Application Code Phrases are as follows:

Assignment of these codes will identify to the Records Main-

tenance, item records, which should not be FIC'd to national stock numbers during BVR reviews and other Indicative Data Change updates. Locally assigned X- series applications codes will therefore be used as a tool for personnel performing item research. Items coded with a second position Z and some other first digit of information indicate that it has a dual function (for example, AZ - would indicate C130 initial Log-in/Health Hazard Review (HHR)). The second position Z indicates it is also an HHR item.
