AFI 36-2903, 29 SEPTEMBER 2002, is supplemented as follows:

It applies to the 45th Space Wing and applicable Air Force tenant units. It supplements wear requirements for Air Force personnel assigned to Patrick AFB and Cape Canaveral AFS. The Uniform Code of Military Justice applies to personnel who violate the specific prohibitions and requirements of this supplement. This supplement does not change required wear requirements established by AFI36-2903.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.

Table 2.2. Men's Battle Dress And Standardized Functional Uniforms.

Line 6 (Organizational Baseball Cap), Column E, NOTE . Only the organizational baseball caps specified in **Table 3.7. (Added)** are authorized. During exercises (mobility recalls) and contingencies, the BDU cap must be worn.

Line 12 (Patches). Air Force personnel are authorized wear of unit, organizational, and morale patches.

Table 2.4. Women’s Battle Dress And Standardized Functional Uniforms.

Line 9 (Organizational Baseball Cap), Column F, NOTE. Only the organizational baseball caps specified in **Table 3.7. (Added)** are authorized. During exercises (mobility recalls) and contingencies, the BDU cap must be worn.

Line 15. Air Force personnel are authorized wear of unit, organizational, and morale patches.

Table 2.6. Clothing/Accessory Standards.

NOTE: Flight Duty Uniform wear of mission patches. Mission patches may be worn once booster is on launch pad until 7 calendar days after a mission. Morale patches and unit colored crew neck T-shirts are authorized on Fridays.

	X		Personnel on tugs towing aircraft support equipment and those driving or riding in open vehicles such as forklifts or scooters (golf carts) are considered to be in a “no hat” area.
		X	During actual loading or off-loading operations at facility delivery bay or doors (between vehicle and facility entrance; in utility uniform only).

NOTE 6 (Added). Patrick AFB Honor Guard wears the double braided aiguillette, white gloves and service hat.

Table 3.4. Distinctive Uniforms--Security Police (SP).

Item	Description/Wear Provisions
Police Whistle	Males: Wear attached to right pocket flap. Females: Wear attached to belt in the right front position.
Bicycle Helmet	White with "POLICE" (black letters) across sides of helmet. Position straight across the forehead. (See NOTE 8 (Added))
Cycling Gloves	Conservative colors as commercially available. Worn when operating bicycles. (See NOTE 8 (Added) .)
Rain Jacket	Lightweight blue jacket with "POLICE" marked on back and security police logo over left breast pocket. Made of wind/rain resistant materials. (See NOTE 8 (Added) .)
Sport Shirt	Light Grey. Short-sleeve, polo-type shirt with "POLICE" marked on back and security police logo over left breast pocket. Letters and logo are black. (See NOTE 8 (Added) .)
Shorts	Dark blue or black knit. (See NOTE 8 (Added) .)
Socks	White. Ankle or mid-calf length. (See NOTE 8 (Added) .)
Footwear	Black athletic shoes. (See NOTE 8 (Added) .)

NOTE 6. Add after "crest": ". .white gloves, and white web belt with MAJCOM crest."

NOTE 7. The gold shield is authorized for wear in lieu of the basic silver shield for current 45 SFS "Gold Shield Award" recipients.

NOTE 8 (Added). Security Forces Bicycle Patrol personnel are authorized to wear the following attire in lieu of the Air Force Uniform:

NOTE 9 (Added). The stocking cap (black navy watch cap) is authorized for wear on the flight line with the BDU uniform, FDU jacket, or parka. When departing the flight line the BDU cap or authorized organizational baseball cap will be worn.

Personnel assigned to 45 SVS/SVMP Fitness Center	Fitness personnel will wear the Services Squadron ball cap. Navy-blue/gray/white wave jacket with Services logo over left breast area. Two tone navy/white stripe, three button, open collar sport shirt with embroidered Services logo on right chest. Navy blue sweat pants with Patrick Fitness Center logo on left thigh area. Navy blue shorts with plain matching belt with a conservative belt buckle may be worn. Black athletic-type shoes and white ankle socks. 45 SVS nametag will be worn on left side to include rank and full name.
Lifeguards assigned to 45 SVS/SVR Outdoor Recreation	Swimwear as provided by the Services Squadron.
Personnel assigned to 45 ADOS/SGGZ Health and Wellness Center	Two button, open collar polo shirt with embroidered Health and Wellness logo on left chest. Khaki pants or shorts with plain brown belt and a conservative belt buckle may be worn. Brown athletic type shoes with white socks. 45th Medical Group Health and Wellness Center nametag will be worn on the right side to include rank and name. MDG organizational cap wear is authorized.
