AFI 34-219, 9 September 1998, is supplemented as follows, and applies to anyone who sells, possesses, or consumes alcoholic beverages in a facility on Schriever Air Force Base. Violations of the 50th Space Wing Supplement 1 to AFI 34-219 may render the offender liable to prosecution and impose civil liability under applicable Colorado statute or render the offender subject to administrative disciplinary action and criminal prosecution under Article 92, UCMJ. Civilian employees who violate these prohibitions are subject to disciplinary actions pursuant to AFI 34-301, *Nonappropriated Fund Personnel Management and Administration*, and AFI 36-704, *Discipline and Adverse Actions*, as appropriate.

2.1. Governing Criteria. Only the Services Division and AAFES may serve/sell alcoholic beverages on Schriever Air Force Base.

2.1.6. Alcoholic beverages may be consumed at:

2.1.6.1. (Added) Softball field on Falcon Parkway.

2.1.6.2. (Added) Services Activity Center (SAC).

2.1.6.3. (Added) 50th Space Wing Headquarters, Bldg 210.

2.1.7. Serving, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages at other than authorized locations is prohibited.
