**FIRE EXTINGUISHING LIQUID FOAM
PROCEDURES**

COMPLIANCE WITH THIS PUBLICATION IS MANDATORY

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Purpose: This instruction establishes local procedures for ordering, processing, and delivery of fire extinguishing liquid foam during a flight line emergency as specified in AFI 32-2001, *The Fire Protection Operations And Fire Prevention Program* dated 1 April 1999, paragraph 3.3.11. This supplement does not apply to Air National Guard or Air Force Reserve forces.

1. General.

1.1. Fire Department (62 CES/CEF) will contact Aircraft Parts Store (62 LRS/LGRDMA) when a flight line emergency requirement exists for fire extinguisher foam. Fire Department (62 CES/CEF) personnel will provide Aircraft Parts Store (62 LRS/LGRDMA) personnel with the requested quantity and the delivery location.

1.2. Aircraft Parts Store (62 LRS/LGRDMA) personnel or Storage (62 LRS/LGRDMS) personnel will determine whether the foam is located in Bldg 571 or Bldg 1177. If located in Bldg 1177, two people will immediately proceed to Bldg 1177. The requested quantity of foam will be pulled and delivered to appropriate destination. Delivery personnel will adhere to all safety requirements, ensuring the foam is properly secured and the speed limit(s) is/are followed.

1.3. If property is available in Bldg 571, Aircraft Parts Store (62 LRS/LGRDMA) personnel will provide Vehicle Dispatch (62 LRS/LGRVO) with the quantity required, Bldg location of where the property is stored and the delivery location. Aircraft Parts Store (62 LRS/LGRDMA) will send a person to Bldg 571 to help Vehicle Dispatch (62 LRS/LGRVO) personnel.

1.4. If Vehicle Dispatch (62 LRS/LGRVO) personnel are unable to deliver the foam, Aircraft Parts Store (62 LRS/LGRDMA) personnel will pick up the property at Bldg 571 and deliver it to the required location.

1.5. The paper work will be processed after the delivery. If the foam was pulled from Bldg 571, no paper work is required since the assets belong to Fire Department (62 CES/CEF). If the property was pulled from Bldg 1177, Aircraft Parts Store (62 LRS/LGRDMA) personnel will process a post-post

issue against organization and shop code 914FD, issue exception code 8, mark for shop use, activity code X, priority 02 and urgency justification AZ. Aircraft Parts Store (62 LRS/LGRDMA) personnel will contact Fire Department (62 CES/CEF) personnel to have them sign the post-post document. The document is then forwarded to Document Control Section (62 LRS/LGRSP) to be filed.
