SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This revision updates wing designation, office symbols, and form numbers.

1.3.10. An inmate's parent unit is responsible for its respective confined personnel, regardless of location, until the members are formally gained into the Air Force Corrections System (AFCS). This responsibility includes, but is not limited to providing escorts, assisting confined members' families, visiting confined members at least monthly, making telephonic contact when geographically separated, and obtaining transfer orders.

7.1.3. The parent unit commander will ensure an inmate has all required clothing upon entry into confinement (Attachment 1). Unless otherwise approved by Headquarters, Air Force Security Forces Center, Corrections Division (HQ AFSFC/SFC), inmates will have, as a minimum, one complete set of service dress, four complete sets of battle dress uniforms (BDU), one field jacket, one short sleeve light blue shirt (or service equivalent), one pair of boots, one pair of low quarter shoes, appropriate belts, headgear, undergarments, socks, and one set of athletic attire and tennis shoes. The parent unit provides missing or unserviceable items prior to confinement or transfer.

8.2.6. Parent units assign only officers and noncommissioned officers equal to or higher in rank to the inmate as escorts. This is not applicable to 6th Security Forces personnel responsible for local area inmate security or control. 6th Security Forces and parent units must be careful not to assign escort duty to any person who may sympathize with the inmate (i.e., a peer who previously worked with the inmate).
