This supplement further implements guidance found in PACAFI 23-206, *PACAF Regional Supply Procedures*. It establishes additional responsibilities and procedures to follow in the execution of, PACAFI 23-206 and higher headquarters directives. This supplement applies to all personnel assigned, attached or associated units to the 8th Fighter Wing, Kunsan Air Base, Korea.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This supplement entirely rewritten based on PACAFI 23-206, 30 December 2000. The 8th Supply Squadron has been reorganized and changed to 8th Logistics Readiness Squadron including office symbols. A bar (|) indicates revision from the previous edition.

PACAFI 23-206, 30 December 2000, is supplemented as follows:

- 2.1.1. 8th Logistics Readiness Squadron, Customer Service (8 LRS/LGRSC) is assigned to the 8 LRS, Management and System Flight (8 LRS/LGRS).
- 5.2.2. Commander, 8th Logistics Readiness Squadron (8 LRS/CC) Option (CLR). 8 LRS Flight Service Center will be responsible for managing Materiel Deficiency Report (MDR) and Quality Deficiency Report exhibits.
- 5.4.12. CLR Option. 8 LRS/LGRSC will manage the Tracer Action Reconciliation (TAR) program.
- 5.4.13. CLR Option. Receiving will manage the Supply Deficiency Report (SDR) program.
- 5.4.17. CLR Option. 8 LRS/LGRSC will manage the Receipt-due-in (356-reject) program.
- 7.3.4. Maintain the Automated Stock Number Directory (ASNUD), (R28).
- 8.4. The Superintendent of Procedures and Accountability (8 LRS/LGRSP) will be Post- Post Control Team (PPCT) Chief. The following breakdown for issue request will be used upon declaration of Post-Post by the CLR and initiation of the Contingency Processing System (CPS):
