SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

2.1.2. Submit nominations via e-mail to HQ AETC/FMP by the last Friday of October for competition in the AETC/FM annual awards. (See nomination procedures in the basic AFI and AETCI 36-2801, *Air Education and Training Command [AETC] Recognition Program*.) In turn, names of the AETC winners will be forwarded to SAF/FME by the first workday in January for competition in the SAF/FM annual awards.

2.1.3. More than one organization per base may submit nominations for the base-level resource advisor. However, all nominations for this award will be channeled through the base comptroller, who will select the base's representative.

4. AETC Comptroller award winners will be submitted for the same award in the American Society of Military Comptroller's recognition program. (See paragraph 5.2.1 in the basic AFI.)

4.2.1. Two (2) individual color photographs (5 by 7 inches) will be electronically submitted within 2 weeks of SAF/FME's announcement of the winners.

4.2.2. Two (2) organizational color photographs (8 by 10 inches) will be electronically submitted within 2 weeks of SAF/FME's announcement of the winners.
