DD2765, Apr 98, CS, Department of Defense/Uniformed Services Identification and Privilege Card, CS, FC3611, see DODI1000-13. Form is issued to identify the following categories or individuals eligible for a Uniformed Services Identification Card: Civilian employees, contractors, employees of the Red Cross, and USO when stationed overseas or required to reside on a military installation; 100% disabled honorably discharged veterans; Medal of Honor recipients; contract surgeons and USS personnel when stationed in foreign countries; MSC Civil Service Marine personnel deployed to foreign countries; non-uniformed ships officers and crew members of NOAA vessels; former members having reached age 60 and entitled to receive retired pay; and foreign personnel in certain categories; VSI and SSB members; and TAMP members. These cards will be electronically generated by the Real-time Automated Personnel Identification System (RAPIDS) using the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS) database.

AF734, Nov 96, EF, Cylinder Liner and Ring Wear Record, EF, FC3230, AFI32-1062. Form is used to record cylinder liner and piston ring wear and establish wear rates of diesel generators. Form is Y2K compliant and replaces CS/CS version which should be disposed of upon receipt of this form.

AF1217, Dec 86, EF, Informational Program (IP) Data Card, EF, FC1610, see AFJI16-105. Form is used to record informational program (IP) activities attended by international students for follow-on training installation and security assistance organization use. Replaces Dec 86, CD/CD edition which will be disposed of upon receipt of this form. Converted from (CD/CD) to EF.

AF1429, Jan 71, EF, Repair Parts Inventory Balance Record, EF, FC2100, see AFMAN23-110V2. Form is used to record inventory and management data of repair parts required for the medical equipment maintenance program. Replaces Jan 71 (CD/CD) to EF.

AF1557, Oct 91, EF, F-100 EHR Report, EF, FC2100, see AFI21-104. Form is used by all Air Force bases and contractors using performing maintenance on the F100 engine. This form is used by all Air Force bases and contractors using and performing maintenance on the F100 engine. This form provides engine flying hours data to the comprehensive engine management. Replaces Oct 91 CS/PD which will be disposed of upon receipt of this form.

AF1829, Jan 82, EF, Refueling Equipment Inspection Record, EF, FC2430, see AFI24-307. Form is used to record inspection interval data and the accomplishment of inspection services and maintenance of fuel servicing vehicle and equipment.

AF2279, May 84, EF, Pallet Identifier, EF, FC2410, JTR. Form is used by terminal operators to enter the number of different types of tie-down equipment. Data will allow for control of the one-for-one exchange of tie-down equipment between the lead-master and terminal personnel.

AF3822, Aug 99, EF, Landing Zone Survey, EF, FC1300, see Afi13-217. Form is used to record applicable data needed to separate into and out of landing zones. Specifically on LZ and to identify required coordination with controlling agencies. All obstacles are recorded (on or near the LZ) that may affect air operations. Replaces Feb 94 edition which will be disposed of upon receipt of this form.

AF4132, Aug 99, EF, FARP Hose Deployment Personnel (HDP) Training Report, EF, FC1100, see AFI11-233. Form is used to document personnel and equipment training status of selected fuel units in hot refueling (FARP) operations.
