1. The legislative initiatives program is a means by which proposals to make changes to Federal law are sponsored to Congress. The legislative initiatives program is not AFMC's exclusive method for sponsoring changes to Federal law. It is, however, a systematic approach which will be used to assure this command, on a periodic basis, assesses changes to Federal law needed to improve AFMC's ability to accomplish its mission and sponsors those having priority to the Air Force Secretariat.
2. This process provides a uniform method for legislative initiatives to become law. As the command's legal experts, AFMC/JA will administer the process. It will solicit proposals, coordinate AFMC staff review of all proposals, obtain HQ AFMC staff coordination for selection of proposals to be sponsored by AFMC, and assure tracking of the progress of proposals.
3. AFMC/CC approves final selection of proposals to be sponsored by AFMC for enactment into law.
