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Manpower and Organization

MISSION DIRECTIVES

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This directive delegates authority to and requires AFMC centers to issue mission directives for named and numbered units subordinate to their center. It requires center manpower and organization offices/divisions (MO/XPM) to develop and maintain center mission directives and mission/functional statements in the Manpower Data System (MDS). It does not apply to the Air National Guard or US Air Force Reserve units and members.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

The revisions in this publication eliminates references to organizations that have been inactivated (SA-ALC and SM-ALC) or no longer assigned to AFMC (SMC).

1. HQ AFMC/XPM will issue a brief AFMC mission directive (AFMCMD) for each unit that is directly assigned to AFMC (Centers, Air Force Research Laboratory (AFRL), USAF Museum and Field Operating Agencies (FOA)). AFMC centers are delegated authority to issue mission directives for their subordinate units. For centers (includes AEDC, AMARC, AFSAC, AFRL and USAFM) that do not have subordinate units, a center-level mission directive is not required.
2. Each center manpower and organization office (MO/XPM), in coordination with the center functional office of primary responsibility (OPR), is required to issue a center mission directive that will contain a brief mission statement for the center's subordinate units. Each center will review and update their mission directive(s) annually (on the anniversary date of the directive) or as required.
3. The HQ AFMC Chief, Manpower and Organization (XPM) and center commanders approve mission directives issued by their organizations.
4. The center MO or XPM is required to create an MDS Organizational Statement Project which will include mission/functional statements for all center organizations, down through the lowest organiza-

tional level shown in MDS. To ensure the mission/functional statements are kept current, the MO or XPM should update the project each time the organization changes.

5. Mission Directive Numbering . Use the numbers in [Attachment 1](#). These numbers derive from AFMD Number 4, which HQ USAF has assigned to AFMC (see AFI 10-101).
