This publication supplements Air Force Instruction (AFI) 36-2903, 29 September 2002, concerning proper dress and personal appearance of Air Force Operational Test and Evaluation Center Personnel. :

### ***SUMMARY OF REVISIONS***

**This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.**

#### **1.2. (Added) General Information.**

1.2.1. (Added) On unit work-days (moving furniture, clean up, etc.), the appropriate uniforms will be worn. Civilian attire is not appropriate and will not be worn by military personnel performing the aforementioned duties.

1.2.2. (Added) AFOTEC personnel will wear the bright-colored Wing and Star patch on the A-2 jacket. Personnel assigned to the Operating Location (OL) at Hurlburt Field, Florida, (HF) and deployed personnel may wear subdued patches.

1.2.3. (Added) Personnel may wear Flight suits, Battle Dress, or any combination of blue uniforms during daily duties at home station. Uniforms will be clean, in good repair, and appropriate to the activity in which engaged.

**Figure 1.1. (Added) Flight Suit Uniform Configuration.**



**NOTES:**

1. AFOTEC bright-colored patch will be worn. Personnel assigned to OL-HF and deployed members in Overseas locations may wear subdued patches.
2. Embroidered name patch (name and badge/wings) will be worn.
3. Optional patch will be worn.
4. Wing and Star bright colored patch will be worn, unless deployed Overseas then a subdued patch is authorized.
5. Cloth grade subdued insignia or plastic metallic grade insignia will be worn for officers.
6. Wear of AFOTEC scarf is optional for AFOTEC personnel. Detachment personnel may wear a detachment approved scarf.

**Table 1.3. Line 1, Wearing the Uniform.**

Dress appropriately for the purpose of the TDY. (Note: It would be appropriate to dress as those with whom you will be working while on the TDY.)

**Figure 2.10. Note 2.**

Wear of the bright non-subdued grade insignia by officers on BDU caps in garrison is authorized.

**Figure 2.11. Note 3.**

The subdued Wing and Star patch will be worn on the right pocket. The subdued AFOTEC patch or the authorized subdued missile or missile maintenance badge will be worn on the left pocket. If missile or missile maintenance badge are worn on left pocket, the AFOTEC patch (emblem) will not be worn.

**Table 2.2. Line 6, Headgear.**

Wear of organizational (AFOTEC) cap is optional. The AFOTEC cap will be dark blue with silver embroidered lettering.

**Line 11, Undershirts.** The wear of black crew-neck undershirts, long-sleeved black or brown turtlenecks, dickies, or thermal undershirts is authorized. Black crew-neck undershirt with the AFOTEC organizational emblem is optional. The emblem is worn on the left side of chest and will not exceed 5 inches in diameter.

**Line 12, Patches.** The subdued Wing and Star patch will be worn on the right pocket. The subdued AFOTEC patch or the authorized subdued missile or missile maintenance badge will be worn on the left pocket. If missile or missile maintenance badge are worn on left pocket, the AFOTEC patch (emblem) will not be worn. Optional: Fighter Weapon School Graduates may wear the graduate patch ½ inch above the name tape. Patches will be sewn on.

**Table 2.4. Line 9, Headgear.**


Wear of organizational (AFOTEC) cap is optional. The AFOTEC cap will be dark blue with silver embroidered lettering.

**Line 14, Undershirts.** The wear of black crew-neck undershirts, long-sleeved black or brown turtlenecks, dickies, or thermal undershirts is authorized. Black crew-neck undershirt with the AFOTEC organizational emblem is optional. The emblem is worn on the left side of chest and will not exceed 5 inches in diameter.

**Line 15, Patches.** The subdued Wing and Star patch will be worn on the right pocket. The subdued AFOTEC patch or the authorized subdued missile or missile maintenance badge will be worn on the left pocket. If missile or missile maintenance badge are worn on left pocket, the AFOTEC patch (emblem) will not be worn. Optional: Fighter Weapon School Graduates may wear the graduate patch ½ inch above the name tape. Patches will be sewn on.
