This supplement implements and extends the guidance of Air Force Instruction (AFI) 13-202, *OVERDUE AIRCRAFT*, 18 March 1994. The OPR for this supplement is HQ AFRC/DOCR. Air Force Reserve supplementary material is indicated by “(AFRC)” in boldface type. This supplement describes Air Force Reserve procedures to be used in conjunction with the basic instruction. Upon receipt of this integrated supplement discard the Air Force basic instruction. This supplement applies to all AFRC units responsible for processing flight plans in accordance with AFI 11-202V3, *General Flight Rules*.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This revision deletes the requirement for OPREP-3 Homeline submission. A bar (|) indicates revision from the previous edition.

1.1.1. When an aircraft is overdue for arrival at an AFRC host base, Base Operations will initiate a PRECOM. When notified that a PRECOM has been initiated, the command post will notify the AFRC Command Center, DSN 497-0680. The AFRC Command Center will notify the AFRC/CV and the appropriate numbered air force (NAF) commander through the NAF command post.
