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This supplement implements and extends the guidance of Air Force Instruction (AFI) 36-2238, 1 September 1996. The AFI is published word-for-word without editorial review. Air Force Reserve supplementary material is indicated by "(AFRC)" in boldface type. This supplement describes Air Force Reserve procedures to be used in conjunction with the basic instruction. Upon receipt of this integrated supplement discard the Air Force basic.

**SUMMARY OF REVISIONS**

This revision changes refresher training from 3 years to 2 years.

4.5. AFRC Medical Group Commander or Medical Unit Commander:

6.3. AFRC personnel must complete SABC initial training within 180 calendar days of their assignment to a mobility position.

9.3. Medical group commander, medical unit commander, or designated representative signs the letter.

9.4. AFRC SABC instructors teach at least two SABC courses within 2 years to maintain their instructor certification.

11.1. AFRC personnel assigned to medical units in a nonmedical AFSC or in a medical AFSC not performing direct patient care, such as Medical Service Corps officers, 4AXXX, 4D0XX, should complete SABC. Completion of wound management and litter carries may be substituted for SABC.

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
