The AFI is published word-for-word without editorial review. Air Force Reserve supplementary material is indicated by “(AFRC)” in boldface type. This supplement describes Air Force Reserve procedures to be used in conjunction with the basic instruction. Upon receipt of this integrated supplement discard the Air Force basic.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This revision aligns this supplement with current instructions within AFI 51-601. A bar indicates revision from the previous edition.

1.3.9. (AFRC) Authority to accept or reject gifts of personal property of the type and threshold identified in paragraph 1.3. is redelegated to the AFRC Vice Commander. Further, the authority to accept or reject gifts of personal property of the type identified in paragraph 1.3. of a value of \$25,000 or less is redelegated to AFRC Numbered Air Force commanders.

1.4.7. (AFRC) The authority to accept or reject gifts of real property of the type and threshold identified in paragraph 1.4. is redelegated to AFRC Numbered Air Force commanders with the authority to redelegate to AFRC installation commanders serving in the grade of O-6 (that is, ART GS-15) or above.
