This mission directive prescribes the mission, organization, and responsibilities for the Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC) 952d Reserve Support Squadron (952 RSPTS).

1. Mission:

1.1. Peacetime. The mission of the 952 RSPTS is to accommodate the assignment of reservists and air reserve technicians to Headquarters (HQ) AFRC.

1.2. Wartime. Functions as an integral part of HQ AFRC in organizing, training, and equipping reserve units to meet gaining major air command wartime taskings.

2. Command. The 952 RSPTS is located at Robins Air Force Base GA and reports to HQ AFRC.

3. Relationships to Other Commands and Agencies. The 952 RSPTS operates at major air command level and as such is authorized normal communication channels with units, numbered air forces, other major air commands, air staff, and other departments/agencies.
