This mission directive prescribes the mission, organization, and responsibilities for the Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC), 954<sup>th</sup> Reserve Support Squadron (954 RSPTS).

***SUMMARY OF REVISIONS***

This revision reflects a nomenclature change for the unit (purpose statement and paragraph 2.) and deletes paragraph 4. A bar ( | ) indicates revision from the previous edition.

**1. Mission.** As the Air Force Element (AFELM) of the Joint Transportation Reserve Unit (JTRU), supports the United States Transportation Command (USTRANSCOM) in providing global air, land, and sea transportation to meet national security objectives in peace and war by maintaining command and control of lift forces and logistical infrastructure, setting operational lift policy, providing crisis planning for force deployment and sustainment, and improving the common-user lift system.

**| 2. Command.** The 954 RSPTS is located at Scott AFB IL and reports to HQ AFRC.

**3. Relationships to Other Units.** Established command channels apply. The 954 RSPTS operates at major air command level and as such is authorized normal communication channels with units, numbered air forces, other major air commands, air staff, and other departments/agencies.
