This mission directive prescribes the mission, organization, and responsibilities for Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC), 953d Reserve Support Squadron (953 RSPTS).

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This revision captures mission statement change to previous edition (paragraph **1**). A “|” indicates revised material since the last edition.

1. Mission. Supports the United States Joint Forces Command (USJFCOM) which maximizes the nation’s future and present military capabilities by leading the transformation of joint forces through joint concept development and experimentation, identifying joint requirements, advancing interoperability, conducting joint training, and providing ready forces and capabilities in support of the Combatant Commands.

2. Command. The 953 RSPTS is located at Norfolk VA and is assigned to HQ AFRC.


3. Relationships to Other Units. Established command channels apply. The 953 RSPTS operates at major command (MAJCOM) level and as such is authorized normal communication channels with units, numbered air forces (NAF), and other MAJCOMs, air staff, and other Department of Defense (DoD) agencies.

4. Organizational Changes. Submit changes to the organizational structure ([Attachment 1](#)) to HQ AFRC/XPM, according to AFI 38-101, *Air Force Organization*. The host unit continues to provide personnel, training, finance, medical, and plans (that is, planning and support agreements) support.
