This mission directive prescribes the mission, organization, and responsibilities for the Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC), 1st Aviation Standards Flight (1 ASF).

- 1. Mission .** Provide combat flight inspection of NAVAIDS, radars, and instrument procedures in support of national mobility plans during wartime, crises, contingencies, and Joint Chief of Staff (JCS) exercises.
- 2. Command.** The 1 ASF, located at Oklahoma City OK, is assigned to the 507th Operations Group and gained by AFRC.
- 3. Relationship to Other Units.** Established command channels apply. The 1 ASF supports the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and as such, is authorized normal communication channels with units, Numbered Air Forces (NAFs), other major commands (MAJCOMs), air staff, and other Department of Defense (DoD) agencies.
- 4. Organizational Changes.** Submit changes to the organizational structure to HQ AFRC/XPM, according to AFI 38-101, *Air Force Organization*.
