AFI 36-2616, 10 December 1993, is supplemented as follows. It applies to Air Force Space Command (AFSPC) and US Air Force Reserve units. It does not apply to Air National Guard units. This supplement will guide the development and reporting of Air Force Specialty Codes (AFSCs) 13SX and 1C6S1 Trainind Personnel Requirements (TPR) for TDY-to-school courses conducted by Air Education and Training Command (AETC).

1.1. (Added) Objectives/Goals: HQ AFSPC, Personnel Programs and Plans (DPP) will provide major command (MAJCOM) functional managers with annual screening instructions upon receipt of Air Force Military Personnel Center (AFMPC) and 2nd AF Programs Branch (DOP) taskings. Usually Sept of each year.

1.1.2. MAJCOM functional managers for AFSCs 13SX and 1C6S1 will task each AFSPC Operations Group to identify their annual screening by rank for each course. Overseas and CONUS-isolated requirements will be reported by month, CONUS requirements by quarter.

1.1.3. Operations Groups will provide their quota requirements to AFSPC, Operations Training and Evaluation Division (DOT), 150 Vandenberg St STE 1105, Peterson AFB CO 80914-4240 within 45 days.

1.1.4. AFSPC/DOT will consolidate all AFSC 13SX and AFSC 1C6S1 quota requirements, coordinate personnel availability with AFSPC, Assignments (DPA), and forward to AFSPC/DPP.

1.1.5. AFSPC/DPP will enter requirements into AFTMS. Usually mid-December of each year.
