This supplement implements and extends the guidance of Air Force Instruction (AFI) 51-601, *Gifts To The Department Of The Air Force*. The AFI is published word-for-word without editorial review. Air Force Space Command (AFSPC) supplemental material is indicated in bold face. This supplement describes AFSPC's procedures for use in conjunction with the basic AFI. It applies to Headquarters Air Force Space Command (AFSPC), its subordinate units, and to all organizations who receive support from Air Force Space Command Judge Advocate offices. It does not apply to Air Force Reserve Command nor Air National Guard units. Upon receipt of this integrated supplement discard the Air Force basic publication.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

The revision of this publication is to meet the format standards required by Air Force. No content material has changed. Some required format changes have been made to allow for the conversion process.

1.2.3. Authority to accept gifts of personal property of \$5,000 or less, that does not require more than negligible expenditure for gift acceptance and maintenance, is hereby redelegated to the Commanders, 14th and 20th Numbered Air Forces and their subordinate installation commanders. This authority will not be redelegated further.

1.2.5.1. Authority to accept gifts of real property of \$10,000 or less, that does not require expenditures for acceptance or annual maintenance in excess of \$1,000, is hereby redelegated to the HQ AFSPC Civil

Engineer, and the Commanders, 14th and 20th Numbered Air Forces, and their subordinate installation commanders. This authority will not be redelegated further.
