### ***SUMMARY OF REVISIONS***

Realigned paragraphs and added Air Mobility Command Regional Supply Squadron (AMCRSS) to current processes. Changed Chief of Supply to Chief, Forward Supply Operations.

1.13.5. Forward Supply Location (FSL) satellite accounts are nonautonomous activities. The Chief, Forward Supply Operations ensures supply support to en route strategic airlift forces is not degraded by SMAG related matters. Chief, Forward Supply Operations will promptly resolve SMAG related problems through the AMCRSS Forward Operations Support Element (FOSE) and Funds Management Element.

1.16.4. TEX code 8 due-out details will not be established at FSL satellite activities. Only select aircraft weapon system spares will be managed by the FSL. Known requirements for these weapon systems will be processed for immediate issue or establishment of a firm due-out (non TEX code 8.)

1.20.2. FSLs will not process forced nonreimbursable issues (TEX code D.)

1.23.1.2. The only credit code "Y" transactions authorized for processing at FSL satellite activities are those assigned by program control (i.e., Materiel Deficiency Report turn-ins.)

1.28.1. AMC RSS Funds Element will establish materiel acquisition control record (MACR) in FSL satellite activities for budget code 9. All MACR factor indicators for budget code 9 are blank.

1.28.2. AMC RSS Funds Element will load a sufficient dollar amount in the maximum automatic obligation authority to ensure uninterrupted requisitioning for stock replenishment and due-outs. Load urgency of need funding flag C.

1.34.1.3. Chief, Forward Supply Operations will periodically review the D08, MACR, to ensure existing maximum automatic obligation authority is sufficient to sustain requisition programs.

1.34.1.16. Chief, Forward Supply Operations will periodically process the R04, FRC Analysis, to obtain a current file of fund requirement inputs and update the requirement computation flag. All FRC images will be immediately processed. Unresolved problems preventing immediate input of FRC images will be reported to AMCRSS FOSE.

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
