AFMAN 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 15, is supplemented as follows: (This supplement is not applicable to Air National Guard or Air Force Reserve units.)

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.

Updates organization and office symbols. Deletes outdated procedures. Revised wording to agree with basic manual. Added paragraph on shipping explosive type assets. Renumbered paragraphs to agree with basic manual.

15C28.5.1. (Added) Assign an alpha shipment exception code "I," exception notice code "R," and exception phrase "For NMCS, verify charging requirement" on all aircraft battery item records. NOTE: The shipment exception code will not stop shipment of batteries processed as post-post or those processed as turn-ins from supply point details; establish external controls to ensure only charged batteries are shipped in support of not mission capable supply (NMCS) requirements.

15C28.5.2. (Added) Personnel Parachutes: Assign a alpha shipment exception code "R" with exception notice code "R" to those personnel parachutes stock numbers listed in AFMAN 23-110, Volume 1, Part One, Chapter 3, para 3.40.1.1 through 3.40.1.1.11. See AFMAN 23-110, Volume 1, Part 1, Chapter 3, para 3.40.1.3, for further guidance.

15C28.5.3. (Added) Assign shipment exception code (SEX) 2 to NSN 2815-01-349-0491. Contact IM prior to shipment for coordination for repair and return. Maintain ECC.

15E1.2.7.6. (Added) Do not ship unserviceable fire bottles and pylons that have not been certified as explosive free. According to T.O. 11A-1-60, paragraph 6.3.1, items exposed to explosives will be

inspected and individually stamped or marked to indicate that they are explosive free. If these items are to be shipped to DOD activities for modification or repair, the DD Form 1570 series condition/identification tag/label will be attached/annotated with the following statement: "This item has been inspected by ___ and to the best of our knowledge and belief are inert/and or free of explosives or other dangerous materiel." Shipping containers will be prominently stamped in half inch letters EXPLOSIVES REMOVED.

15E1.2.14. (Added) Do not ship excess serviceable parachutes to FB4620 without direction from the item manager. In those instances where the item manager directs transfer to DRMO, supply will force ship the parachutes to FB4620.

15E1.2.14.1. (Added) Stencil all parachutes shipped to FB4620 with the following: "NOT FOR FLIGHT - GROUND TRAINING ONLY."
