9.16.1.1. (Added) Support of D-BRITE Programs Only. D-BRITE requisitions for CONUS bases will first be sourced from the source of supply (FFZ). Lateral support will only be used once confirmed delayed status is received from the Federal Aviation Administration (G69). Bases with D035A access do not have visibility of available assets at G69. So do not consider a zero balance at FFZ delayed status.

9.18.2. Budget personnel will send a priority list of budget code "Z" requirements to HQ AMC/FMAO.

9.32.1. Routing identifier "JBI" does not apply to AMC units.

9.42.1. See AFI 65-603, *Official Representation Funds Guidance and Procedures*; AFI 38-401, *The Air Force Suggestion Program*, for other restrictions and guidance for procurement of awards and gifts. Bases may use the International Merchant Purchase Authorization Card (IMPAC) for purchase of awards and gifts within the dollar thresholds prescribed in the *United States Air Force Internal Procedures for using the IMPAC*, 28 APR 97, soon to be AFI-64-117.

9.47.1. (Added) NEXRAD lightning strike recovery kit:

9.47.1.1. (Added) In an attempt to reduce system downtime, the National Weather Service has developed a lightning strike recovery kit (NSN 5998-01-416-1900). The kit consists of the following:

9.47.1.2. (Added) The following procedures will be used when recovering the radar from a lightning strike:

9.47.1.3. (Added) Maintenance will order the recovery kit as nonrecurring, project code 579, delivery priority 02, UJC 1C, RDD of 999, and FAD II override if necessary.

9.47.1.4. (Added) Use parts necessary from the kit to repair the system.

9.47.1.5. (Added) Place the kit in AWP status and order the replacement parts, recurring, delivery priority 02, and UJC AR against the DIFM document number. When all replacement parts are received, turn in the kit as serviceable. This will credit the exchange price to the customer.

9.47.1.6. (Added) Supply must expedite the serviceable kit to the National Weather Service (National Reconditioning Center), 1520 E Banister Road, Kansas City, Missouri 64131-3064, RIC G13, DODAAC 136453. Do not allow the kits to remain in stock on the item record as there are only four kits to support the NEXRAD, tri-agency users.

9.111.2.8. (Added) Purchase of Fast Payback Capital Investment Program (FASCAP). To ensure prompt support of FASCAP requisitions through local purchase channels, process these requisitions as special or command interest projects. Annotate all associated FASCAP documentation "FASCAP requirement." Assign a priority to the requisition commensurate with UND and FAD. Off-line requisitioning procedures apply.

9.112.1. At the option of the COS and with the concurrence of the contracting office, the following action may be taken to clear 317 rejects. Stock control or LP receiving may coordinate with the base contracting office or inquire the BCAS to obtain information necessary to input LPS status to the SBSS.

9.118.3. Stock control will submit corrected error notices within 1 workday.
