AFI 36-2209, 28 February 1994, is supplemented as follows: (This supplement does not apply to Air National Guard (ANG) and United States Air Force Reserve units.)

3.8. Direct requests for training to HQ AMC/DOTL for sending to HQ USAF/XOOT.

3.12. (Added) Request formal training quotas for all personnel who qualify for training under guidelines established in paragraph 6. To preclude loss of training funds, do not return quotas allocated to AMC units to AFMPC if there are individuals eligible for training assigned to the requesting organization. HQ AMC/DOTL must approve emergency exceptions.

3.13. (Added) The training and standards division (or equivalent) at each AMC unit will ensure compliance with this paragraph, will ensure accurate records are maintained on all crewmembers, and will document all formal SERE training courses attended and graduation dates.

NOTE: Optional crewmembers are authorized to attend United States Air Force formal survival training courses if their forecast normal flying activities involve risks that justify the training.

4.3. (Added) AMCI 11-301 outlines the AMC Triennial Combat Survival Training (CST) Program and complements training required by AFI 11-301, *Life Support Program*, and the basic instruction as supplemented. CST is required for all AMC aircrews regardless of primary aircraft authorization (PAA) code.

NOTE 3. AMC SOLL II aircrew members are authorized to attend subject course. Quotas should be requested through HQ AMC/DOTL.

NOTE 9. AMC life support personnel whose duties include serving as instructors in unit continuation training programs must attend S-V90-A and are authorized to attend S-V86-A and S-V87-A. Unit SERE

instructor personnel (AFSC 1T0X1) are authorized return to S-V80-A and S-V87-A on a triennial basis to maintain proficiency commensurate with their AFSC.
