SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This issuance updates the Air Mobility Command supplement by supplementing paragraphs **1.2.4.**, **2.6.1.**, and **4.5.1.** There are no other significant revisions to this supplement.

1.2.4. After notifying the CLLO of any OSC inquiry or investigation, immediately notify HQ AMC/JA and the appropriate NAF/JA of any OSC inquiry or investigation.

2.6.1. After notifying the CLLO and HQ AMC/JA of the petition for a stay, the base liaison officer will notify the appropriate NAF/JA when the OSC serves an activity with a petition for a stay. Information copies of any reports, requests, statements, analyses, and other documents required by the basic instruction to be submitted to SAF/GCA, through CLLO, will be sent to HQ AMC/JA and the appropriate NAF/JA.

4.5.1. Information copies of employee requests for representation will also be sent to the appropriate NAF/JA.
