



ADMINISTRATION OF MILITARY JUSTICE

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OPR: HQ AMC/JAJ (Lt Col Hillyer)
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AFI 51-201, 2 November 1999, is supplemented as follows. This publication applies to all Air Mobility Command units and members. This supplement does not apply to Air National Guard and United States Air Force Reserve units.

- 1.1. This supplement has been coordinated and approved by AFLSA/JAJM.
- 2.5.2. Coordinate any request for Secretarial Exception through the appropriate Numbered Air Force and the HQ AMC legal offices.
- 2.8.3. The power of the AMC/CC to grant waivers is delegated to the AMC/CV.
- 3.3.4. Send an information copy to HQ AMC/JAJ, 102 E. Martin St., Rm N-119, Scott AFB IL 62225-5012.
- 5.7.1. The duties described shall be the responsibility of the Command Paralegal Manager.
- 6.2. The duties of the AMC/CC are delegated to the AMC/CV.
- 6.6.5. Send an information copy to HQ AMC/JAJ, 102 E. Martin St., Rm N-119, Scott AFB IL 62225-5012.
- 7.17.2. (Added) Article 6, UCMJ-type visits by the Staff Judge Advocate (SJA), Air Mobility Command, will normally include an assessment of responsible installation officials' awareness and compliance with AFI 51-201 requirements, as well as the effectiveness of installation victim and witness assistance program.
- 10.1.9.1. Also send a copy to HQ AMC/JAJ, 102 E. Martin St., Rm N-119, Scott AFB IL 62225-5012.
- 10.1.9.2. Also send a copy to HQ AMC/JAJ, 102 E. Martin St., Rm N-119, Scott AFB IL 62225-5012.
- 12.3.1. Due to the time sensitivity of these responses, the suspense date to JAJM must be met. Ensure required replies are provided in a timely manner to AFLSA/JAJM, with copies concurrently provided to appropriate Numbered Air Force and HQ AMC legal offices to ensure simultaneous receipt. Where time

permits, coordinate the response with the appropriate Numbered Air Force and HQ AMC legal offices before dispatching the response to JAJM.

12.8.5. AMJAMS will be the primary method for creating and updating officer/special interest reports. However, if the AMJAMS cannot be updated in a timely manner or if a matter warrants special immediate notice to JAJM or if information is forwarded to CCZ, the officer/special interest report should be sent electronically to JAJM via e-mail to <mailto:jajm.sir@pentagon.af.mil>, with information copies simultaneously sent to the appropriate Numbered Air Force and HQ AMC/JAJ.
