**SUMMARY OF REVISIONS**

**This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.**

1.7. (Added) **Special Interest Cases.** The servicing Staff Judge Advocate will forward a special interest case report to HQ AMC/JAJ through 18 AF/JA before nonjudicial punishment action is taken in such cases.

2.7. **Delegation of Authority.** The powers of the Commander, AMC, are delegated to the Vice Commander, AMC.

2.10. **Withholding Authority.** Authority to impose nonjudicial punishment on commissioned officers is withheld from all commanders, except those who are general officers or who exercise general court-martial convening authority and their principal assistants to whom Article 15 power has been delegated under paragraph 2.7 of the basic instruction.

3.13. **Member's Presentation.** If the Commander or Vice Commander, AMC, is the commander imposing punishment and the member is not located at Scott Air Force Base, Illinois, the subordinate commander who served the AF Form 3070 is hereby designated to hear the personal presentation of the member. The designated commander will forward through command channels his or her recommendations for disposition of the case.

Note 2. The power of the Commander, AMC, to reduce a CMSgt or SMSgt by one grade is delegated to the Commander, 18 AF.

4.4. **Delegation of Authority.** The powers of the Commander, AMC, are delegated to the Vice Commander, AMC.

6.8. **Procedures.** For cases involving colonels and selectees: If a decision has been made to file the action in the selection record, send a copy to HQ AMC/A1O. For cases involving other officers (Lt Col and below), send the copy to HQ AMC/A1FM. In all cases involving AMC officers (not just those from AMC headquarters) send an information copy to HQ AMC/JAJ, 102 E. Martin St., Rm. N119, Scott AFB IL 62225-5012.
