AFI 51-401, 19 July 1994, is supplemented as follows: (This supplement does not apply to the Air National Guard and United States Air Force Reserve units.)

3.1. Installation staff judge advocates will implement a program to ensure all personnel assigned to units located at or attached to their bases receive appropriate annual training in LOAC.

3.2. Installation staff judge advocates will track the number and percentage of personnel assigned to units located at or attached to their bases who receive training in LOAC during each calendar year. Report the following information through NAF/JA to HQ AMC/JAO, 102 E. Martin St., Rm N-119, Scott AFB IL 62225-5012, by 20 January each year:

Maximum number of personnel assigned during calendar year

Number of personnel who received training during calendar year

Percentage of personnel who received training during calendar year

Description of training provided (include areas covered, manner of training, and differences in training provided to personnel)

Recurring issues or concerns raised during training
