AFI 51-503, 1 December 1998, is supplemented as follows: (This instruction does not apply to Air National Guard or US Air Force Reserve units.)

2.1.1. The Commander, AMC, as AIB convening authority for all AMC mishaps, herein delegates that responsibility to AMC/CV.

3.2.3. Any deletions in Part 1 materials, other than normal personal information redactions, will be coordinated with HQ AMC/SE. HQ AMC/SE will advise AFSC/SECD of the change.

7.2.1. (Added) The Commander, AMC herein delegates the authority to approve early release of information to the AMC/CV in all cases in which authority to convene the respective AIB has been delegated.

9.2.1. (Added) The NAF/DRU SJA will provide to HQ AMC/JA by message, e-mail or facsimile the details of any administrative or judicial action contemplated and a summary of claims arising from the incident.

10.7.1. The AIB convening authority herein delegates to the AMC/JA authority to approve wreckage release prior to forwarding to AFLSA/JACT for final action.
